- Your Civil Ceremony
  If you choose to hold your Civil Ceremony at the hotel, you must contact the Dorset Registration Service. The presence of two Registrars is required for your marriage to take place, one to conduct the Ceremony and the other to Register the Ceremony. A charge for the attendance of these officials is required to be paid to them as soon as possible after the notice of Marriage has been given.
- Notice of marriage has to be given to the Registrar in the district where you live. It must be given in person and is valid for
- If the Registration District is different from the one where the Marriage is taking place, the couples must obtain the authority before the ceremony and ensure that it is lodged with the Registrar who is attending the Wedding.
- The content of the Civil Ceremony must be agreed, in advance, with the Registrar. Any music, poetry or readings etc. which forms part of the ceremony must be secular.

## Renewal of Marriage Vows

• Many couples choose to renew their Marriage Vows which are often associated with a special Wedding Anniversary. A souvenir certificate is signed during the ceremony.
